Public's Right to Address the Will County Metropolitan Exposition and Auditorium Authority Board

- I. The public's right to address the Will County Metropolitan Exposition and Auditorium Authority (Authority) Board about an agenda item shall be accommodated prior to any resolution regarding that item.
- II. Non-agenda Will County Metropolitan Exposition and Auditorium Authority-related comments shall be heard prior to adjournment or prior to action to move the Board into executive session.
- III. Members of the public
 - A. May speak for five (5) minutes.
 - B. At the sole discretion of the Authority Board Chair, irrelevant, repetitious, or disruptive commentary may be terminated.
- IV. A majority of Board members present shall remain in the conference room while members of the public address the Board.

Public's Right to Record Open Meetings of the Will County Metropolitan Exposition and Auditorium Authority Board

The public's right to record open meetings of the Authority shall be accommodated as follows:

- I. There shall be no restrictions on handheld recording devices.
- II. Audio recording equipment containing data storage devices adequate to record a minimum of two (2) hours may be placed on the conference table. Should a meeting exceed two (2) hours, a break will be taken to allow storage device replacement.
 - A. Corded audio recorders may be connected to any of the several available electrical outlets in the room.
 - B. Such recorders to be placed on the conference table shall:
 1. Be positioned in such a way that, in the opinion of the Board Chair, does not interfere with or in any way impede the movement of Authority members and staff seated at the table,
 2. Remain in place until the meeting is adjourned, and
 3. Have a twenty (20) foot cord, at a minimum.
 - i. Such cord may be taped to the floor at the discretion of the Authority Board Chair.
- III. Video recorders and/or film cameras:
 - A. Due to meeting room space constraints, recording equipment shall not be moved around the table nor from place to place.
 - B. Tripod positioning shall be as space limitations allow.
 - C. Individual(s) shall adjust and/or maneuver equipment in such a way that:
 1. The public's view is not obstructed
 2. The public's ability to hear is impeded.
 3. The business of the meeting is not disrupted.
